Attached to the mainland by a short causeway, Denarau is the place to be pampered. Jump on the Bula Bus the only transport you'll need around the island, explore the Big Bula Water Park for families plus the many day trips from Denarau to the surrounding islands. Getting Around

Getting around Fiji is easy. There's a good network of buses and ferries for travel within Fiji's main islands, and taxis are common. Hiring a car is a good way to explore the two largest islands — or charter a boat or small plane to get between islands. Small ship cruising is a great option to explore the outer islands.





The Temperature

Fiji has two seasons: warm and even warmer. It's a sunny, tropical climate. That doesn't mean it never rains, but you can expect May to August, the cooler months, to range from 18° to 29°c. Then from December to April, the temperatures register from 22° to 32°c.

Time Zone

Fiji has a shorter daylight saving period over summer, so for a few weeks in spring and autumn there is an hours difference but other than that the time zone is the same.



Don't miss

- Getting in or on the water. Fiji is the soft coral capital of the world and has some of the most magnificent snorkelling and diving sites easily accessed from the resorts. Most resorts offer complimentary non-motorised water sports so enjoy stand up paddle boarding or kayaking at your leisure.
- Visit an authentic traditional Fijian village and experience a traditional welcome kava ceremony and tour of the village to see what village life in Fiji is like. Usually the villagers will display their handicrafts at a craft market for you to pick up some mementos for home.



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
